



Epinephrine Consent Form

The school nurse shall have the primary responsibility for the administration of epinephrine. However, the certified school nurse may designate additional employees of the school who volunteer to be trained in the administration of epinephrine via a pre-filled autoinjector mechanism using standardized training protocols established by the Department of Education in consultation with the Department of Health and Senior Services when the school nurse is not physically present at the scene.

The school nurse or designee shall be available on-site at the school in case of emergency. In addition, the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) must be informed that the school, its employees and agents shall have no liability as a result of any injury arising from the administration of epinephrine to the pupil. The parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of the pupil must sign a statement acknowledging their understanding the school shall have no liability as a result of any injury arising from the administration of the epinephrine via a pre-filled auto-injector mechanism to the pupil and the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) shall indemnify and hold harmless the school and its employees or agents against any claims arising out of the administration of the epinephrine via a pre-filled auto-injector mechanism to the pupil.

The permission for the emergency administration of epinephrine via a pre-filled auto-injector mechanism containing epinephrine to pupils for anaphylaxis is effective for the school year it is granted and *must be renewed for each subsequent school year.*

According to N.J.S.A. 18A:4012.5, we acknowledge our understanding that The Laurel Education Group, its employees and its agents shall have no liability as a result of any injury arising from the administration of the epinephrine to our child, and we indemnify and hold harmless The Laurel Education Group and its employees or agents against any claims arising out of the administration of the epinephrine to our child. We hereby grant permission to the School Nurse and/or a trained delegate, to administer epinephrine via a pre-filled auto-injector mechanism, to treat our child for anaphylaxis. If the school nurse or delegate is unavailable, 911 will be called immediately.
